

Hybrid Seating & Table Base Appearance Expectations

The seating combines the same wood stock as the Wooden chair for the seat/back and marries it to a clear coated steel tubular frame. This frame is acid washed and then dipped in a neutralizing bath to prepare it for a clear "dead flat" powder coat sealant that protects the metal without making it appear "prepared".

This treatment allows for character marks including rust stains, handling blemishes and yard marks. The welds are prominent and feature burn marks and evidence of minor slag spatter beneath the powder coating. These design intentions are not cause for rejection. The overall goal is for this look to "wear in" as the chair ages, much like an old leather coat's blemishes and wear marks make if more desirable.
