

Standard Floor Cleaning Procedure for New Furniture Package

Our new furniture package is incredibly popular with both operators and customers alike, bringing a fresher, cleaner look to our dining rooms. To keep that look and maintain your new furniture will require some changes to your routine dining room cleaning regime to prevent unnecessary stain and rust build up.

Effective immediately, the new required floor cleaning routine will be as follows:

Step One: Move all furniture to one side of the dining room, clearing approximately half of

the dining room floor space.

Step Two: Thoroughly clean the floor space you just cleared and allow it to become

reasonably dry.

Step Three: Move all of the furniture to the side of the dining room you just cleaned,

vacating the side you need to clean next.

Step Four: Thoroughly clean the floor space you just cleared and allow it to become

reasonably dry.

Step Five: Replace all furniture in the dining room as per your specified plan.

Why is this procedure being implemented?

The obvious trend is that floor cleaning is involving moping around chair and tables, rather than moving them. The resulting mop head impact to the chair legs abrades the finish on both wood and metal chair legs exposing the raw material to the dirty mop water. In the case of wood chairs, the legs become increasingly dirty and more difficult to clean. In the case of metal chair legs, the exposed steel begins to rust, especially around the intersection of the glide and leg interface.
